

The following is a summary of all studies reviewed since the inception of Quality Partners. As you will see, more than 85% of the time high-end imaging studies were completed as ordered. 10% of the time a more appropriate study was utilized. In less than 5% of cases, after a peer-to-peer discussion, a mutual decision between the ordering physician and reviewing radiologist determined that the study ordered was not indicated.

These results illustrate how, through physician-to-physician collaboration, this program allows for the most appropriate care to be provided without unnecessary burden.
